2. Objectives of Sizzle and Grow - Organizing Food fest

- (i) Enable practical learning through self- organization and participation.
- (ii) To develop a sense of team work and togetherness.
- (iii) To showcase cookery skills and bring out business tricks of students.
- (iv) To provide a platform to enhance socializing and communication skills of the students.
- (v) To drive students from digital world to real world through their actual presence and participation in the Food Fest.
- (vi) To provide platform to students to enrich and discover their leadership skills.

3. Context

Food Fest was organized in the college premises to mark International Day of Family. Family members were encouraged to participate with their wards taking part in the event. Students from different streams of the college enthusiastically participated in the Food Fest. Food Stalls with food of nutritional value and variety in taste were prepared and sold by the students. The students executed the event through a week-long discussion and meticulous planning with their teacher mentors and peer team. Their planning and execution also instilled within them a sense of responsibility towards their work which thereby groomed organizational skills of the students. 4. Practice

The Parents' Involvement and Direct Participation with their wards in this event strengthened the Parent-Teacher Association of the college which thereby encouraged the concept of healthy linkage between Educational Institution and Society.

5. Evidence of Success

The event received an overwhelming response. And such response instils confidence in the students and motivates them to work with sincerity and zeal in future. Volunteers should be trained for waste management.
