This functional and educative short program runs under the aegis of various departments. The successful participants who attend minimum of thirty hours are issued certificates. These are academic and skill development credentials awarded to students who complete a much comprehensive program in different subjects. Following are some of the certificate courses conducted in St. Thomas College, Bhilai. Some of these courses can be attended by teachers, school students and those who have a special interest in the respective topics. The department of education runs a programme on Music- Classical, Vocal and Instrumental. The objective behind it is to develop analytical, creative and intuitive understanding of music. The department of Management runs a professional business skill development program. This program targets all round development of business skills like positive thinking, body language, high motivation in job etc. The department of English runs a short term course on Communication Skills and LSRW Proficiency through Digital Language Laboratory. The college has a fully equipped language lab with latest ETNL software, for this purpose. The department of Zoology runs a certificate program on Inland Aqua culture pertaining to farming and management of freshwater fin fishes and shellfishes. Department of Botany has developed two certificate program on Soil Analysis and Seed Science. To enhance the skills required for testing and analyzing soil and equip with skills to assess the seed quality for certification respectively. It is very essential that along with formal academics every person needs to develop his personality and bloom in all respect. With this vision Department of

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Psychology runs a program on 'How to be a complete Human', a course on personality development. Department of Mathematics and computer science runs a certificate program on the topic 'Enhance your programming skills', where the student is taught to become a better coder. IQAC and NCC organize a certificate program on Disaster management. Department of Chemistry conducts a certificate program on Analysis of Water Quality. This program focuses on purity of water, harvesting of water and other aspects of water conservation. Department of Economics and Civil services aspirant club runs a certificate program for "Economics for Civil Service Aspirants". In 2020-21 academic sessions, the above mentioned programs were conducted online.

Faculty Development Program for Teaching Staff

The College has a rich experience in conducting FDPs on various areas of digital specialization and pedagogical programs. The Covid-19 induced pandemic has changed the entire world order and has deeply affected the educational system disrupting the traditional class room teaching. It has forced to switch over to online teaching and learning. With this the teaching fraternity has begun to face myriad challenges in the use of e-learning resources with professionalism. In this backdrop, our College This Year due to Covid -19 pandemic organised many online short term certificate courses for the purpose of institutional development, Departmental growth and movement to higher grades under the career advancement of the faculty members. These programme basically aimed to familiarise teachers of the college with the different components of information technology for effective teaching and learning.

Faculty Development Program for Non-Teaching Staff

The College is also very conscious about overall development and improvement of teaching and non-teaching staff. By this view the college takes the initiative by organizing various workshops, seminars in collaboration with colleges and IQAC. The training program on Basic computer training was organized for all non-teaching staff. Academic Activities
